

One of the finest Lutheran organizations in Central Pennsylvania is Camp Mount Luther. For more than 60 years, this wonderful camp and retreat facility has provided us with a "place apart" for renewal and spiritual growth.

Congregations look to Camp Mount Luther as a resource in providing a valuable ministry to our youth and families. We, at St. Matthews, have sent children to camp and used Mt Luther facilities for many years for youth retreats. We, personally, have benefitted from "camp" as children, as adult leaders, and as adult campers.

Because of the need for Camp Mount Luther to upgrade and modernize its facilities, the congregations of the Upper Susquehanna Synod, including our congregation, will conduct a Capital Campaign to help raise \$1.6 to \$2 million. 
